Will this CE credit count toward my license renewal?

This course is approved by CAMFT (Continuing Education Provider #61115) and meets the qualifications for 6 hours of continuing education credit for LMFTs, LCSWs, LPCCs, and LEPs as required by the California Board of Behavioral Sciences.

Licensees outside California are responsible for confirming with their own state licensing board that CAMFT-approved CE hours satisfy their renewal requirements before enrolling.

What if my state doesn't accept CAMFT-approved CE hours?

Many state licensing boards accept CE from CAMFT-approved providers — either directly or under reciprocity provisions. Acceptance varies by state and license type, so verify with your own licensing board before enrolling if formal CE credit is your primary reason for purchase.

Even when CAMFT CE doesn't satisfy your state's renewal requirements, the course remains valuable clinical training. You receive a documented certificate of completion listing hours, topic, and provider — commonly accepted by supervisors, group practices, and employers for professional development credit. More importantly, the clinical content itself is a framework for working with perimenopausal, menopausal, and post-menopausal clients that is rarely covered in graduate training or other CE offerings. The case vignettes, assessment tools, and reference materials are designed to be returned to in practice long after the course is complete.

What format is the course delivered in?

Self-study / distance learning. Each module includes a mix of video lectures, audio narration, reading materials, and clinical case vignettes. All video content includes closed captions.

How long do I have to complete the course?

Course access is granted for one year from the date of enrollment. All requirements — module content, post-test, and course evaluation — must be completed within that year to earn CE credit. Certificates cannot be issued for incomplete enrollments after access expires.

What happens if I don't pass the post-test?

The post-test requires a 70% minimum passing score. You may retake the test as many times as needed within your one-year access window at no additional cost.

How will I receive my CE certificate?

Your certificate is auto-issued through Thinkific upon completion of all course requirements: 100% lesson completion, passing the post-test (70%), and submitting the course evaluation.

The certificate includes your full name, license number, course title, CE hours awarded, completion date, provider name, and CAMFT provider number.

Can I get a refund?

A full refund is available within 3 days of purchase if no course modules have been accessed. Once any module has been opened in the learning management system, no refund is available.
